

Apprenticeship for Supporting Teaching & Learning in Schools

Crowan Primary School, part of Southernly Point Co-operative Multi-Academy Trust, is looking to recruit a **Teaching Assistant Apprentice Level 2/3** for 30 hours per week [including college attendance] over 38 working weeks [school term time].

Crowan Primary is a thriving small school situated between Helston and Camborne where the commitment to teamwork and the provision of a balanced, enriching and engaging curriculum are highly valued.

The successful applicant will be expected to support teaching and learning across the school but predominantly in Key Stage 2 in the first instance.

They will be expected to support individuals and small groups of children, some with mild learning difficulties, during lessons across the school curriculum under the direction of the class-teacher.

They will be required to undertake playground duties and the supervision of children when required under other circumstances, including visits during the course of the school day.

The successful candidate will need to be able to deliver planned activities to the children, to assist their learning and discussions, to observe and record the children's outcomes, and to be able to report this back effectively to the class-teacher.

Other routine duties will include photocopying materials, preparing resources and helping with the day-to-day management of pupils' needs.
